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# What Blended Learning isn't...

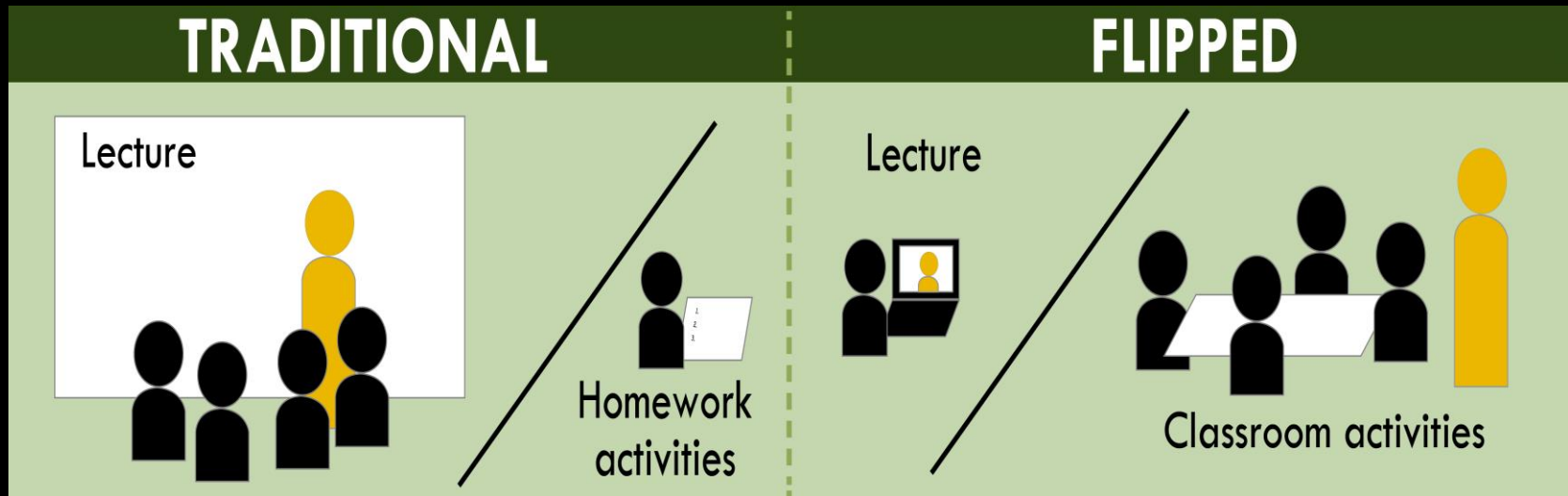
- Replacing teachers with computers
