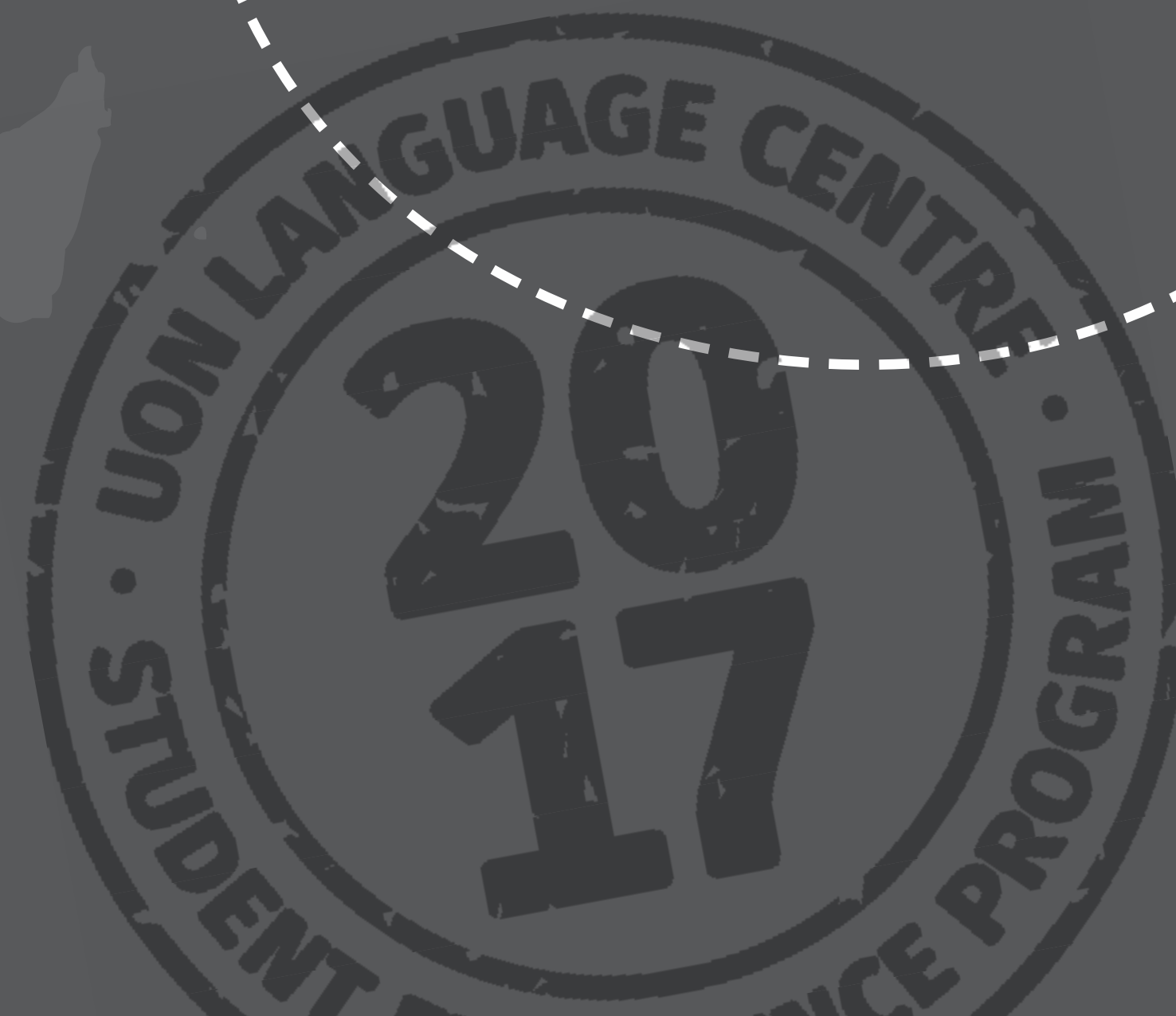

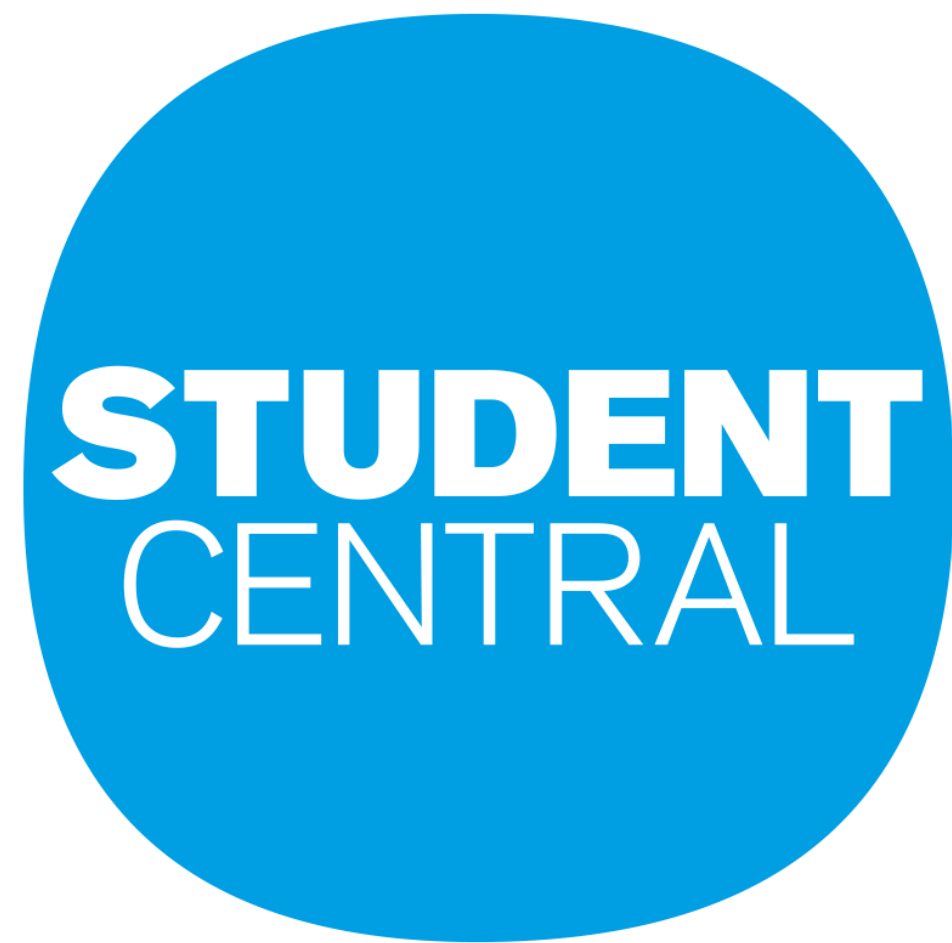

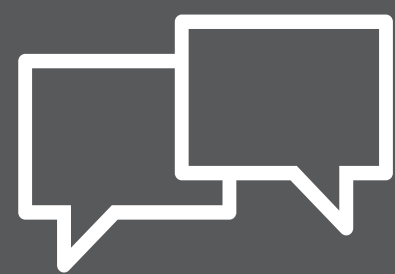

**It takes longer than one day to settle in to a new country and learning environment.**

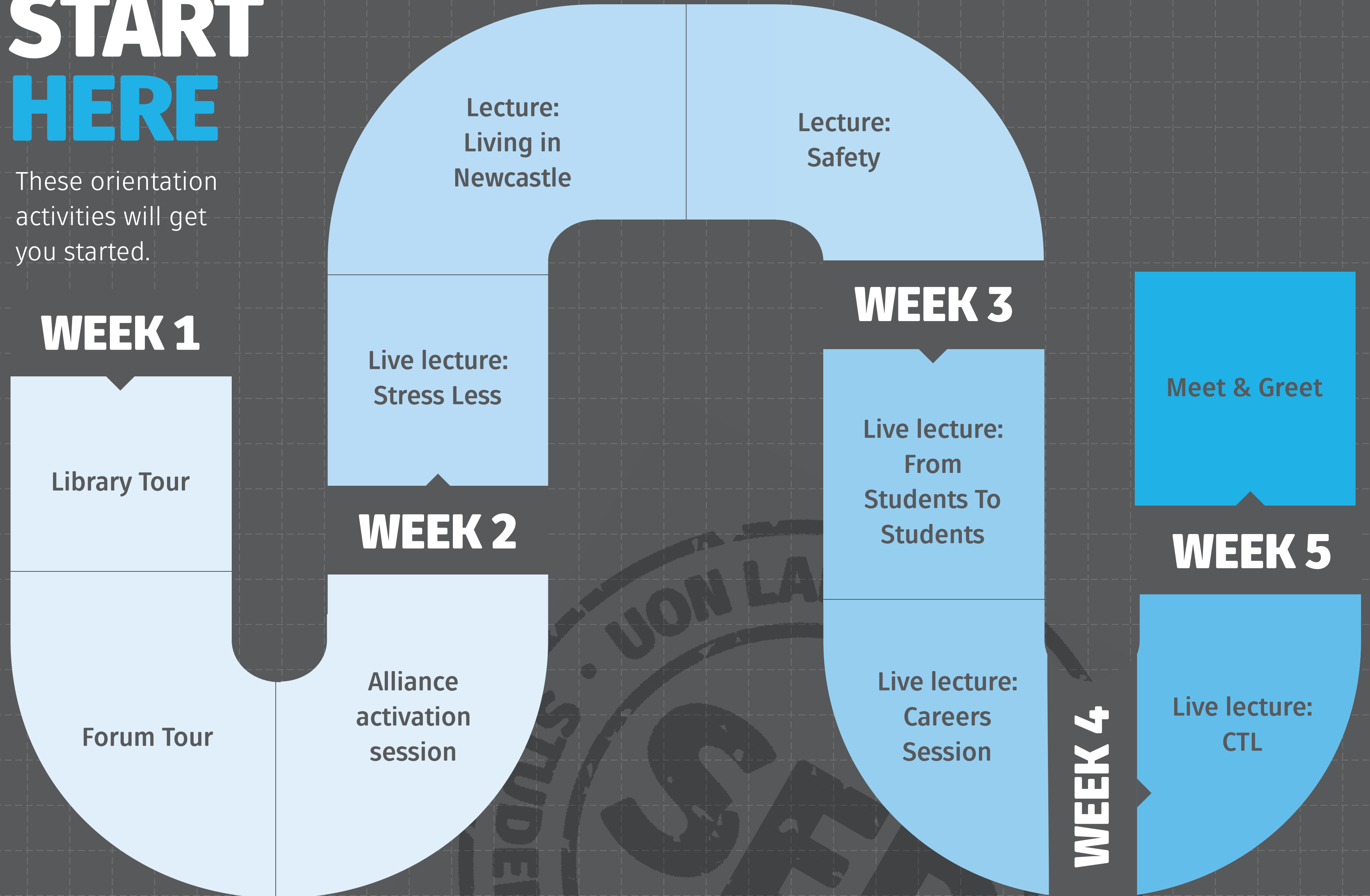
That's why we run an ongoing orientation program that involves a range of activities to ensure you settle in to life in Australia.
